MedStar Family Choice requires laboratory/pathology procedures to be provided by MedStar Family Choice participating lab(s). The following labs do not need to be sent to a participating lab and can be performed in an office setting.

The following labs can be done in the office by any provider specialty:

80305	Drug Test, presumptive, direct optical observation
81025	Urine Pregnancy Test
82272	Occult Blood, 3 Cards for Colorectal Screening
83036-QW	A1C Testing
83655	Blood Lead Testing
86580	Intradermal TB Skin testing (not a lab test)
87205	Smear for bacteria, virus, fungus

87220	KOH on Tissue
87420	Immunoassay technique for RSV
87430	Immunoassay technique for group A Strep

The following labs can be done in the office by an urologist in addition to the urology visit:

Procedure Code	Description
81000	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent; non-automated, with microscopy
81001	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent; automated, with microscopy
81002	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent; non-automated, without microscopy
81003	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent; automated, without microscopy
81005	Urinalysis; qualitative or semiquantitative, except immunoassays
81015	Urinalysis; microscopic only

The following labs can be done in the office by oncologist/hematologists:

81000	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent; non-automated, with microscopy

The following labs can be done in the office by pain management specialist in addition to a pain management visit:

Procedure Code	Description
80305	Drug test(s), presumptive, any number of drug classes; any number of devices or procedures, (eg, immunoassay) capable of being read by direct optical observation only
80306	Drug test(s), presumptive, any number of drug classes; any number of devices or procedures, (eg, immunoassay) read by instrument-assisted direct optical observation
80307	Drug test(s), presumptive, any number of drug classes; any number of devices or procedures by instrumented chemistry analyzers
G0480	Per day, 1-7 drug class(es), including metabolite(s) if performed
G0481	Per day, 8-14 drug class(es), including metabolite(s) if performed
